- 5. <u>Final Escrow Release for Weatherstone Commercial WaWa</u> Arro Engineering has reviewed the final As-Built Plans and is recommending the release of the final escrow amount. The amount recommended to be released from Escrow is \$22,759. This request is based on the approved Development Agreement.
- 6. <u>Approve Resolution No. 13-2022</u> Preliminary/Final Subdivision Plan Approval for 613 St. Matthews Road for a Five-Lot Subdivision.
- 7. <u>Approve Resolution No. 14-2022</u> Authorizing the Amicable Acquisition of 1925 French Creek Road at a cost of \$420,000.
- 8. Authorize Administration to Obtain Bids for the Purchase and Relocation of the House located at 1925 French Creek Road The administration is seeking authorization to obtain bids for the purchase and relocation of the house at 1925 French Creek Road.

- 12. Accept Bid from Asphalt Maintenance Systems in the Amount of \$359,307 for the Paving of Streets in the Weatherstone Development The administration received one (1) bid for the project. The bid estimate was \$351,130. The project will be funded from the Highway Aid Fund and Road Capital Fund.
- 13. <u>Accept Bid from Cedar Hollow Recycling for Road Materials</u> The administration received two (2) bids for road materials. Cedar Hollow Recycling has been supplying road materials to the township for a number of years.
- 14. Accept Bid from Asphalt Maintenance Systems in the amount of \$1,081,369.24 for the Paving of Kimberton Road, Hilltop Road, Shady Lane and Sheeder Mill Road The administration received one (1) bid for this project. The estimate for the project was \$965.248. The paving will be paid from the Road Capital Fund.
- 15. Accept Bid from Workforce Construction in the Amount of \$94,980 for the Repairs to the Kimberton Road Bridge The administration received six (6) bids for this project which will be funded form the Capital Road Fund. The estimate for the project was \$160,000.
- 16. <u>Request Speed Limit of 25 MPH on Horseshoe Trail</u> The administration has received a request to lower the speed limit on Horseshoe Trail to 25mph. A speed study will be requested.
