Coordinated required police spaces, adjacencies, and security requirements based on today's best practices





















EXISTING FLOOR PLAN APPROX. 520 S.F. POLICE (+ storage spread throughout existing building)

BEST PRACTICE BLOCKS - 6,500 s.f.




















Proposed Massing + Gabled Roof Forms














Proposed Massing + Gabled Roof Forms – Police Entrance View







Existing Conditions

Two independent reports in 2021 and 2022 noted the barn to be in poor structural condition Original mid 1800's wood framing in disrepair **Roof framing not** sufficient to meet modern building codes Floor framing would not support any sustainable load due to rotting







Examples

- Cracked wood members separating from roof structure
- Some wood roof trusses are twisted and compromised







Examples

- Light gage roofing not insulated or structural
- Existing has wrapped and is now wavy











Proposed Reconstruction

- Stabilize and repair existing stone end walls
- Rebuild the interior structure with steel
- Create floor two levels for loading of materials and vehicles
- Roof structure able to support future solar panels
- Restoration company to salvage existing wood framing







- Separate public from construction work
- Maintain cartway for public work vehicles
- Create area for contractor parking
- **Increase stormwater** management to accommodate police

Construction Site Organization:

- Temporary relocation of police function to trailers
- Maintain public access to police functions and Township building
- Safely segregate construction site from public access







Schedule and Next Steps Summer 2022:

- Hire civil engineer and begin site survey and investigations
 - Complete 3D scan of existing barn structure

Fall 2022

Restart design committee to review barn reconstruction and police station addition







Schedule and Next Steps Winter/Spring 2023:

- Complete design and bidding documentation
- Finalize all required approvals

Summer 2023

Bid the project as per
 Pennsylvania procedure

Fall 2023

- Begin ConstructionJanuary 2024
 - **Construction Complete**
