**ORDINANCE NO. 207**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WEST VINCENT CODE OF  
ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 338, REGULATING MAXIMUM SPEED  
LIMITS ON CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN WEST VINCENT TOWNSHIP**

**BE IT HEARBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of West Vincent Township, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

**Section 1.** The West Vincent Code of Ordinances, Chapter 338, Vehicles and Traffic is hereby amended to amend the following street speed limit identified in the Code:

§338-8 Speed Limits. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for the part of the street:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Speed Limit (mph)</u>	<u>Location</u>
Flint Road	25 mph	Between St. Matthews Road (SR 1031) and Kimberton Road (T-561), a distance of approximately 4,500 feet


**Section 2.** Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
