

# 2025 ROAD PROGRAM BID PACKET

## INFORMATION & DIRECTIONS

- Bids must be received at the West Vincent Township Building, 729 Saint Matthews Road, Chester Springs, PA 19425 by 1:00pm on Wednesday, May 28, 2025. The Township Building is open Monday to Friday, from 8:30am to 4:30pm, excluding holidays.
- All bids must be sealed. Envelopes containing bids shall be clearly marked "Bid Proposal for letting of May 28, 2025".
- All bids received will be publicly opened on this same date at 1:15pm.
- In the sealed bid bidders must include:
  - 1. a completed and signed MS-944 Form;
  - 2. a completed MS-944 Attachment 1 Form;
  - 3. a completed and signed MS-944 Attachment 1-A Form;
  - 4. a certified check or bid bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid, issued by a surety licensed to do business in Pennsylvania; and,
  - 5. a completed and signed Anti-Collusion Affidavit.
- All bidders must bid on the Base Bid. Bidders may bid on Alternate Bid 1 and/or Alternate Bid 2. The low bid will be calculated only on the total of the project components approved for award by the Township. For example, if the Base Bid is \$100, and the Alternate 1 bid is \$75, and the Alternate 2 bid is \$50, and the Township approves for award the Base Bid and Alternate 1 bid only, the low bid is calculated at \$175. And if the Township approves for award the Base Bid and Alternate 2 only, the low bid is calculated at \$150.
- The winning bidder must furnish a performance bond and a payment bond prior to the start of work, with each bond in the amount of 100% of the total bid. Bonds shall be issued by a surety licensed to do business in Pennsylvania.
- Once submitted, bids cannot be withdrawn for 60 days after bid opening.
- The West Vincent Township Board of Supervisors reserves the right to accept or reject any
  or all bids, or waive any irregularity of the bids, as submitted, in the sole discretion of the
  Board of Supervisors.

## **NOTICE**

West Vincent Township is soliciting sealed bids for its 2025 Road Program. Bids must be received at the Township Building, 729 Saint Matthews Road, Chester Springs, PA 19425, M-F, 8:30am to 4:30pm, until 1:00pm on Wednesday, May 28, 2025. All bids received will be publicly opened on this same date at 1:15PM. Complete bid forms and instructions are available at the Township Building, and at westvincenttwp.org.

The work includes the labor, materials, and all equipment required to install Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course, in specific UTBWC, Gradation B, PG64-22, SRL-H at six township roadways. Materials to be installed total up to an approximate 30,500 CY.

A certified check or bid bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid shall be required to be submitted with the bid. The winning bidder must furnish a performance bond and a payment bond prior to the start of work, with each bond in the amount of 100% of the total bid. Bond shall be issued by a surety licensed to do business in Pennsylvania.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Township Building at 10:00am on Friday, May 23. Questions may be submitted to mhogga@westvincenttwp.org. Questions received after 2:00 PM on Tuesday, May 27 will not be acknowledged.

- 2 If more than one proposal on any project is submitted by an individual, firm or partnership, corporation or association under the same or different names, only one lowest proposal will be considered.
- 3 Description of Work- -
  - A. If additional space is needed, insert appropriately numbered attachment and note "Continued on attached work sheets."
- Part A of Page 1 to be completed by municipality. Part B of Page 1 to be completed by contractor. Schedule of Prices Column #1 (Item), #2 (Approximate quantities), #3 (Unit, i.e., ton, square yard, linear feet, etc.) And #4 (Description, i.e., bituminous materials 9.5 mm S & L, 12.5 mm Wearing, 25.0 mm Base Course, etc.) Must be filled in by the municipality to insure equitable bidding. Columns #5 (Unit Price), #6 (Total) and total amount of bid, must be filled in by the contractor. If more space is needed, add note at the bottom of the page; "Continued on Attachment No. 1-A", and add additional sheet designated as Attachment No. 1-A, 1-B, etc.. Repeat for each additional sheet required. As required by Publication 408, Section 102.06(e),each bidder must submit a completed Form 7126 Anti-Collusion Affidavit with its bid proposal.

Contracts in excess of \$5,000.00 in Second Class Townships and in excess of \$10,000.00 in First Class Townships, Boroughs and Third Class Cities bonds must be in 100% of the amount of the contract. Bond Forms MS-944 Attachments 2 and 3 and Workmen's Compensation Affidavit Attachment 4 must be submitted by the successful bidder within 20 days of the contract award. Failure to submit the bonds shall constitute grounds to cancel the contract.
- \*Construction projects, where the estimated cost of the total project exceeds \$25,000, are subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act 442.
