- Equipment for Opalanie Park is on order. This includes the playground, gazebo, and viewing stand equipment.
- Evans Park Gazebo – Party occurred during Labor Day weekend, signage may still be visible.
  - ⇒ ACTION: Validate signage remains and if so, contact the manager for removal. (Davey)
