III. P&R Survey –

⇒ ACTION: Lindsay to send out survey for feedback, she will synthesize responses and resend adjusted survey.

IV. Bark Ranger Program continues to proceed. Bandana will be royal blue and mustard yellow, shield will have West Vincent colors.

⇒ ACTION: Ken to follow-up with township to determine when receptacles will be installed in Opalanie.
