ANNOUNCEMENTS & INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

- Chair Alan announced the Board of Supervisors met in Executive Session on February 26 to discuss matters of land acquisition, in specific (a) three properties less than 10 acres and north of Horseshoe Trail, and one property less than ten acres and south of Horseshoe Trail; (b) matters of litigation, in specific Cellco Partnership vs. West Vincent Township Zoning Hearing Board, Chester County Court of Common Pleas Docket No. 2025-11271-2B, and Lindquist vs. West Vincent Township Board of Supervisors, Chester County Court of Common Pleas Docket No. 2025-11876-CS, and a matter of potential litigation, in specific Conditional Use Application 2026-01, Pulte; and (c) a personnel matter, in specific employee benefits.
- This evening’s meeting was recorded for rebroadcast.

PRESENTATIONS

Opalanie Park mural – Ken Alan, Parks and Recreation Commission, provided an overview of a project to install a painted mural on an existing structure at Opalanie Park. Mr. Alan commented on proposed mural designs, the Parks and Recreation Commission’s preferred mural design, structure surface prepping, and project logistics and expenses.

Community Day – Mr. Alan commented on a proposed Community Day event. There was general discussion as to event schedule, offerings, staffing, volunteers, various logistics, and expenses.

Fellowship Trail – Mr. Alan commented on a proposed opening dedication ceremony for the Fellowship Trail. There was general discussion as to event schedule and various logistics.

Chester County Preservation Partnership Program Round 38 – There was general discussion as to the next round of grant funding made available by the Chester County Preservation Partnership Program, and potential improvement projects at Evans Park. The Parks and Recreation Commission will consider these projects, and will submit their recommended project to the Township Manager.
