- I. Meeting called to order at 1904.
- II. March 4, 2026, meeting minutes approved (James 1<sup>st</sup>, Jane 2<sup>nd</sup>)

Old Business:

- III. “Yoga in Opalanie Park with Ally Antonini” - Confirmed time/dates:  
10-11AM on Saturday 4/25, 5/9, 6/6, 6/27, 7/11, 7/25.  
Advertising Plan: Obtaining signs (16) with QR codes that take the scanner to a landing page with more information and a way to RSVP.  
⇒ ACTIONS:
  - Ken will post on West Vincent Voices
  - Ken will request township admin to post on Facebook and include in Peek at the Week
  - Ken will place signs
  - Jennifer (Hankin Library & Ludwig’s Hardware) and Jane (Whole Foods & Birchrunville PO) will leave flyers.
- IV. P&R Survey – Committee discussed updates to the survey, which will be shared with Lindsay for incorporation.  
⇒ ACTION: May P&R meeting discuss how survey will be dispensed.
- V. Bark Ranger Program – Bandanas scheduled to arrive on 4/2. More discussion needed on advertising.  
⇒ ACTION: Ken to organize a pop up dog walk at Opalanie on a Saturday or Sunday as the first way to advertise the program.
- VI. Fellowship Trail - Completion is expected by May 1. Ribbon cutting / commemoration ceremony proposed for 6/17 at 1900, rain date 6/18.  
⇒ ACTION: Davey to check to see if the 4-H Club will provide ice cream paid for by the township.  
⇒ ACTION: Ken to approach Kimberton Whole Foods about providing popcorn or something edible that is not impacted by the weather.

- VII. Fall Fest at Opalanie Park – Proposed 10/10.
- ⇒ ACTION: Ken to reach out to each individual member to determine interest in participating in the Fall Fest and to what degree.
  - ⇒ ACTION: Meeting topic for May meeting.
- VIII. Discussion regarding Wilsons Corner Park focused on enforcement issues and creating natural deterrents of the behaviors being observed. For example, placing boulders to prevent unwanted vehicular behavior.
- Discussed a resident's desire to install a commemorative picnic table at Wilson's Corner. Board determined to approach by reviewing what all Parks need and then providing that as options to residents who are interested in this type of commemoration.
- ⇒ ACTION: Ken to schedule a visit of Wilsons Corner Park for Jane and James.
  - ⇒ ACTION: James to submit ideas for the Park.
  - ⇒ ACTION: Ken to email the Township Manager regarding installation of the trash and dog waste receptacles at Opalanie as well as the fishing line at Wilson's Corner Park.
- IX. Opalanie Park mural – Public Works will be power washing and applying primer to the building façade in May which is a slight delay to the original agreement. Additionally, the Art team is redesigning the proposal based on the guidance to not paint over the windows and doors. Awaiting Tracey Schiavello's evaluation and agreement to the path forward.
